Reading Guide:

In these advanced lessons you will dig deeper into the Word of God, the Bible. It's a followup of the beginners lessons. As mentioned in the Beginners lessons, the material is -at-it-is. Taken from Facebook where it was send in short messages, here on this website, you'll find all of the different files in main steps so you have all the same step-messages in one document. Later in time we hope to re-order the steps to a more smooth document. In our lessons we use the abbriviation that is more or less common in the evangelical world. A abbriviation as Ex.1:10-15, stand fort he tekst in the bibelbook Exodus, chapter 1 verse 10 up to and including verse 15.

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Step 2 The fear of the Lord



Sadock → Ezekiel 43: 19 / 44: 15 – 28

Habakkuk → 1: 2 - 4 / 2: 1 - 4Maleachi → 1: 14 - 2: 2-11 3: 2-5 4: 2

1. Part 1 About: Sadock

The man who lived with His men according to that *inner low* of *Zoë Words* and by the *Spirit* of the *MOST HIGH*! - I'll Give some key verses to be samples / very deep lessons about our subject:

the Fear of the Lord "

Which is to be found there - particularly as guidance for us as for many before us and also for the many more to come! To those whom are called to that precious →Revelation 1: 6 r - priesthood! In Ezekiel 43: 19 God loved those priests there a lot as they were fully attracted by HIS heart! - Read now also about them in 44: 15 -28! In the O. T. it was about the natural but this sample learns a lot about the spiritual ministry shown in the Revelation 1: 6 - dedicated priests / warriors as well!

Some high-lights here!

A *pure* covenant: no inner contact out of the flesh - read: *Colossians 3 & 2 Corinthians 5: 17 / all of 6!*. With as ultimate purpose for us is the becoming of

"Dwelling places of: the Lord of hosts "!

An operating in linen clothes out of that inner exchange our the souls and hearts as shown in *Matthew 11: 28 - 30 / Colossians 3* and in *1 Peter 1: 9* this as promised in *Ezekiel 26: 36* - Fully anointed with that 7 fold Spirit from Isaiah 11: 1 - 3 re - read deeply <u>Step 2 (the regular lesson)</u> - Here in Ezekiel the wool stands for: fleshly works - *all in vain* and *hated* by the Lord: religious works → not born out of a intimate relation - done in sweat! Then go to Ezekiel 47: 1 - 2 about: that break - in the Dutch Bible: it was filled with bubbling up water out the rooms from the Sadock priest! The Lord showed me it was the fruit of real / pure worship from out of there holy dedication and passion unto GOD -!

Beloved – mention this: we are serving this - by his grace - to you to help you to be well prepared for His divine calling: a servant's heart purpose – restored and refreshed to teach and guide the others!

<u>Mention the results</u>: → They were qualified to serve: "the <u>BLOOD</u>" and fat sacrifices a very high privilege! Also they were ordained to have wisdom to teach by the Isaiah 11: 2 Spirit of Wisdom & knowledge - this a.o. for discernment to judge! Realize it was not allowed to appear out of the inner place unto the outside crowds in linen as the anointing might struck those people there –!

In the Dutch NBG it is prescribed that the water of that temple break is bubbling up out of wells in the Sadock priest's rooms - these dedicated closest *holy water of LIFE* friends of Yahweh reflected innerout a fire-full worship which filled that break with "a stream of adoration" Mention almost everything that touches this water will live. Realize that these potential sources contained lots of healing power plus Godly wisdom to teach and discernment to be able to judge - a very important part in there ministering as priests of the **MOST HIGH!**

A personal note!

Having that *fire full / intimate relation* is essential - here is Jesus shown in Isaiah 50: 4 -10 as our *BIG* Example! - Very important also is 1 John 1: 9 for the redemption unto the stopping with sin! You are ordained and in the former period of our Seminar well skilled - now we will enter to the next level in ministry. Read please also Revelation19 as well - then particularly about that linen there and about that bride both in the 2nd part! Much on this will be as a refreshment and it'll take you to that next class in the Seminar but it'll have to come *from out of your mind right into your heart and soul*! As a most holy transformation of your: soul / heart & conscious - needed for that high calling in ministry! It's the very important part of our serving to God!

1.1. On - Part 1 The practical session on fb

Please do read *Ezekiel 43:* 19 / 44:15-28 / 47: 1-2 and 48: 11 and put them in the Spiritual realm as I did! All of those scripts are linked and there contents are very relevant! In order to understand how to teach the people you are going to serve!

So you can tell me now about the wool / linen and where those do stand for/ do you remember the events in Revelation 19!

Yes: they stand for purity / holiness

The wedding and His preparation of the linen robe unto this event here the wool is symbolic for serving in own man power for our Lord: stinking religious fleshly works – the wool is forbidden in the temple!

Yes but also for the preparation unto that warriors wedding - mentioned in 19 the 2 nd part - this in HIS inner room as: He hates the flesh and it gives a bad smell in HIS nose: "He deserves the smell of Song of Songs 4: 11 -14 "! Mention here the virgin whom stands for no covenant to idols or fleshly behavior - do also remember here: Colossians 3 / 1 Peter 1: 9 and 2 Corinthians 17: 5 / chapter 6 all about the 2 phase in preparation of the divine Melchisedec priests!

Private garden, treasure, bride, like a spring well insight that is a fountain out of my new inner being see:1 Peter 1: 9 about salvation of souls and about the transformation processes of the renewed soul - a pleasure in His nose!

In the Dutch NBG - it shows: the refining process / glorification of our souls - followed up by the phase of preparation of the: "*Priests - ministry of reconciliation*"! Now please do repeat:

<u>Step 2</u> (*Regular lessons*) and be refreshed - along with these please pay also attention to the scriptures added to the lecture of <u>Step 2</u> so we'll be most optimally prepared for the high calling - in spirit / heart and soul!

2. Part 2 About - Habakuk

Please do read *Ezekiel 33* and also *Isaiah 52: 7-12*. His frustration Habakkuk shows here in ch. 1 and then later on in 2: 1- 4 He applies as Watchman unto His LORD; God meets Him there and encourages him by promising: "*The Word will be fulfilled*"! - Even in verse 14 this until His glory will fill it over all! Then in ch. 3 God shows Himself to Habakkuk in those Words of power and great expression particularly in verse 9 and in verse13 something very nice happened –! Go a while now please to the Lord's creation of arrows in *Isaiah 49: 3:* He does compile these arrows - well prepared unto one spear and comes to the rescue of His anointed One - all of this was very impressive to Habakkuk in verses 16 - 19 we can observe His reaction!

Here Habakuk is as in Ezekiel. 33 / Isaiah 52 a watcher - prophet / interceder of the Most High full of expectation! See also Psalm 40: 1 in Dutch → full of fire I waited→ however in English → patiently! I think both are of highest importance - to move the heart of our Lord! Then the Lord meets him and urges him to stay alert as HIS promised Words will come to pass! You need a deep desire to draw HIS attention! Also compassion to conduct HIS living Words and to see HIM approach you - even in Psalm 17:14 this coming accelerates in all new things and in that awareness and depth of the comparison is amazing!

A personal note

Herewith as announced on FB-chat - about: Habakkuk - also a prophet whom feared the Lord and hated the evil around him! Please look to next scripts 1 st.: Isaiah 11: 1-3 → verse 3 & 50: 4-8 then Proverbs 13: 8 - Psalm 45: 7 / Hebrew 1: 9 and 5: 7 -10 The fear of God is shown among others in these 3 men of God all however ministering in different areas: Sadock + his priests where very faithful to Him and they were there His favorites! Out of their rooms the water of worship welt up that did feed the holy break of the Temple! Our Lord didn't chance - so now our worship will result in a likewise resort!; Habakkuk was as we shared above a: prophet watchman / intercessor!

2.1. Part 2 The practical session on fb

Mention Habakkuk is going into a deeper / higher level in chapter 3 where God shows him <u>WHO HE IS</u> particularly in verse 14 and further! Mention He is the sovereign Lord so decisions about whom to use and when are up to HIM then in 3: 15 he joins all arrows to 1 spear and is coming very quickly for the rescue of His beloved anointed ones! Read chapter 3 - please all of it (deeply) and be impressed! Yes I just did - Habakkuk has a very good ability to describe God so eloquently and so massively

Please my friends do later meditate on it deeply as it is very essential! ok

Verses 14 - 15 He'll use us: well prepared and eager to be used! Habakkuk is really impressed by God's attitude and Being and his soul / body reflect powerfully on it knowing and realizing: "this" GOD is able to take care over all of His live and He conducts all unto HIM and starts magnifying HIM abundantly - Glory!

Amen!

This should happen to us much more!

As in Jesus spoke conversation with the Samaritan women at the well \rightarrow she was really thirsty denied /rejected *as* she came at the well in noon time all other in evening!

3. Part 3 About Malachi

Please do read

Malachi 1: 7 -10 + verse 14 / 2: 1-11 / 3: 3 - 5 & 4: 2

This prophet / purifying servant writes a lot about priests who were backsliding from the *Most High* by losing respect for the precious / holy things of God - then they started to sacrifice unworthy and inferior animals and also they did start to worship idols; also in the spiritual they committed adultery - in the Dutch Bible it says this was caused by a lack of spirit inside! Also singers / worshippers of Judah where fallen back (*here Judah = praise*) so God didn't appreciate their songs any more. Then in chapter 3: "*The purifying Angel*" of the Lord takes them apart and starts to bring them through a heavy process of cleansing after that; their ministry was restored! Then in chapter 4 we find 2 groups: they that had lost their inner contact with Yahweh and they that were still in love with and faithful unto Him; please read and meditate on this deeply as it shows that: God grants to those who are faithful the beautiful blessing of a young spirit and a joyful hart - *the* essence of attitude needed by all our *Co - Working* ministering!

This concluded the additional series of lessons on our <u>Step 2</u> as a reminder please read and meditate on

Isaiah 50 : 4 - 9 / 11: 1 - 3 → verse 3 linked with: Proverb 13: 8 / Psalm 45: 6 - 8 / Hebrew 1: 9 and 5: 5 - 10 here we see our: "King-High / Priest" in His development!

A personal note

Without guidance by the Spirit of: Isaiah 11 vs. 3 those words become letters empty and condemning! In 2:1-11 God tells the people that He bar tired of their complains / crying and groaning; because the Lord witnessed their vows that they took on their wedding day and they have been disloyal the lord made them one in body and spirit. He tells them to be guarded and to remain loyal to their wife! Malachi here shows the hurt in the heart of His precious friend our *Most High* - It urges him to write Chapter 3 on: the cleansing of those "Judah - priests" - this by a holy Angel; Then in chapter 4 he shows a.o. that to God deeply dedicated group; whom lived with Him in great owe − God was delighted with them and granted them some awesome promises → read about it in the last part of chapter 4 ok ?!

3.1. Part 3 - The practical session on fb

Can you please give me your point of view on Malachi - What did make him special compared to the Melchisedec - priesthood as shown in revelation 1: 6 in God's sight?

Exactly there in that Melchisedec priesthood there will be no falsehood there was no cheating, lying or broken offering. Jesus was pure, holy, truth and light > Here they spoiled the intimate relation!

That's why Yahweh was grieved about their hearts attitude! Remember this <u>Step 2</u> is all about the most intimately & the fearful relation with our Lord! Yes -Just as we are the church which is Christ bride we as his wife should remain loyal to Him and Him alone. Yes but in spirit they served idols - it says in Dutch bible: *lack of spirit caused this*! Enough spirit gives desire to God's seed is living Words! Amen and also by means of intimate relation with Spirit and the Word as Jesus had in Isaiah 50: 4 - 10 & Isaiah 11: 1 - 5! So they failed in 3 aspects though the Lord had shown them - the faithful Levi as he was walking in the ministry; God ordained him to!

Then it was enough even with Judah! They sung without dedication in their hearts so there in chapter3 the Refiner comes in very heavy! Malachi 3: 3-5 the coming Day of Judgment God will judge - a refiner of silver watching very closely to make sure the dross is cast out. Just as sinful spirits will be judged. Then after that cleansing process the Lord accepted offerings of praise once more and He judges them accordingly.

Sometimes the process of purification after multiply warnings - has to be done - as it involves HIS holiness! Mention this was about Judah = praise so His worshippers in expression! Yes **I did forget** that but am aware

They also lost that special fragrance read Isaiah 11: 3 please! Yes that was my next Step I was waiting for you to finish, great minds - I do think alike!

The <u>FEAR OF THE LORD</u> it came back with the purification! Jesus carried that particular fragrance called fear of the Lord / **hatred towards evil**! It caused God to anoint Him according to Psalm 45: 6 - 7 and Hebrew 1: 9 with tremendous joy!

Isaiah 11verses 1 - 3: Out of David's family a shoot will grow. a branch bearing much fruit from the old root, the Spirit of the Lord rests on Him who grows, Jesus, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and might and the Spirit of fear of the Lord, He will delight in obeying the Lord and He will never judge by appearance, false evidence or hearsay.

Now go to Hebrew 5: 5 - 10 this joy carried Him through all trials – preparing Him for that new *Melchisedec* priesthood!

Ok

Last verse as a fruit of that relation with the Isaiah11 verse 3 Spirit → this along with hating of evil!

Amen!

So giving to GOD is a fruit of intimacy. Look in Malachi 4 - a big part of the crowd was backsliding like their leaders so - as a Sheppard so their flock some however where pure and preserved He wants us as leaders to be / become have a desire to become like those God fearing - favored!

I do have that desire -!
