## 1. Introduction

As I did promise at the end of Step 4, herewith a deeper and wider view unto the being of the Holy Spirit: aspects; gifts; fruit(s) and administrations of this precious Person. Already in the 1st book of the O.T. we find the expression:

*Let US make men, in Hebrew. El Elohim - plural form.*

This stands for: “the Three in One God”- the “Holy” Trinity of the Father, the Son and Holy Spirit. In this book is also mentioned the next scripture: Gods Spirit was breathing on the waters! - so He was there all of the time! In the O.T. - it speaks many times about this divine Person resting on men of God in those days or even attaching a special person apart.

The largest in the O.T. and the smallest in the N.T.- who was predicting the coming of Jesus as the Baptizer with this Spirit was John the Baptist. In concern to our lessons about this wonderful Person it might take a lot of time, endurance and dedication to develop a deep and stabilized relation with this divine and precious Trinity !

This includes the awesome fellowship with the beautiful but severe Person of the Holy Spirit. Processes as prescribed in former lessons need to be worked out very seriously and deeply in our live-system. This in order to: create a strong and solid foundation for God to build His passionate church on - His temple!

In a former lesson: I did share on the subject: the Baptism in water! It was Peter in Acts 2 who answered on the request: “What do we have to do to be saved?”→ Repent -Turn your lives to God and be baptized and you will receive the gift of the: Holy Spirit!

So the same promise the disciples received according to Joël 3 & Acts1 was also given to

Israel and later on to all mankind. Here the period of the administration of this precious Spirit started and it will endure till Jesus returns on / with the clouds and with Him his woman in all her divine glory an event I do long to partake in !

So now we will start to study on this divine Person:

“The holy Spirit of God”!

1. The very foundation of moving in the: "Gifts of the Spirit" is **Love!** Paul Said: "[Follow after Love](#)" - [1 Corinthians 14: 1!](#)
2. We must earnestly desire to: "[The gifts of the Spirit](#)"! The gifts are such that they are freely given to anyone who desires them.
3. The gifts are for service and for meeting the needs of the people! The gifts are tools for the specific Job / Administration!
4. We'll need to release the: "[Gifts of the Spirit](#)" in our lives by starting to move in them - this because we are carrying somebody's breakthrough, healing - deliverance and / or miracle!
5. The gifts are not so we can be entertained - they extend and reveal the: "[Kingdom of God](#)" - they must be used to reach the world!
6. Since the Holy Spirit is the One Who shows or manifests God's presence in the world it is not surprising that Paul calls the spiritual gifts: "[Manifestations of the Holy Spirit](#)"! [1 Corinthians 12: 7.](#) The gifts are also proves of the presence of God in the Church!
7. We have been told to: "**Do pursue the best gifts**" - Every gift is available to the believer. We just need to desire most for the best gift!
8. The gifts are divine treasures because they are a manifestation of the Holy Spirit and can not be separated from this Person or His presence - so do live in deep and close harmony with Him!
9. We need to desire the spiritual gifts because God longs for His people to be built up and encouraged, consoled and pleasing unto Him [1 Corinthians 14:3!](#)
10. We need the: "Gifts of the Spirit"- because God commands it! [1Corinthians 12:31; 14:1 & 39.](#) In fact God tells us:  
"[Do not forbid speaking in tongues](#)"  
"[Do not quench the Holy Spirit & Don't despise prophecies](#)"  
[1Thessalonians5:19-20.](#)

All of these are empowered by: "One and the Same Spirit" - Who apportions to each one individually as He wills! [1 Corinthians 12:11 - ESV!](#) We are vessels that receive his **Grace** and we must make ourselves available and pursue for the gifts. The greater we pursue **and** let love overflow in our hearts the more the Holy Spirit will entrust and enable us with: "**His - Gifts!**"

### 3.1. I The Spirit of the Lord

**Definition:** Reveals the ever present source of power, ability and support

Attributes:

1. Jesus attributes His ministry to the “Spirit of the Lord” - Luke 4: 18
2. a 7 fold meaning of Jehovah: “The Great I AM” stated by Moses!
  - a. JEHOVAH JIREH: My Provider
  - b. Genesis 22: 17 - the Lord will provide
  - c. JEHOVA NISSI - He Who is: My: Victory / Banner-flag or Exodus17: 15 - the Lord is my Banner
  - d. JEHOVAH RAPHA: My Healer
  - e. Exodus15:26 - I am the Lord that health thee
  - f. JEHOVAH SHALOM: My Peace
  - g. Judges 6: 24 - Gideon built an alter there unto the Lord, and called it Jehovah Shalom
  - h. JEHOVAH ROAH: Who is My Shepherd
  - i. Psalm 23: 1 - the Lord is my Shepherd
  - j. JEHOVAH TSIDKKENU: My Righteousness
  - k. Jeremiah 23: 6 - the Lord our Righteousness
  - l. JEHOVAH SHAMMA

- m. It adds continuous victory Proverb :21-22 and verses 30-31
- n. It ensures the correct building of a house Proverb 24: 3
- o. It gives inheritance of strength Eccl.7: 11-12; verse 19
- p. It gives you a radiant shining and confident face Eccl.: 1
- q. It is better than the strongest weapons Eccl. 9: 18
- r. It gives irresistibility of spirit and speech Acts 6: 10
- s. It gives pureness and peace James3: 17
- t. It is experiencing all that is in Jesus Colossians 2: 3
- u. It is stability of your being and salvation Isaiah 33: 6
- v. It gives a refreshing wellspring of advise and health Proverb12: 4; 15: 7; 18: 4

### 3.3. Step 5 c III The Spirit of understanding

A. Definition: Having insight or revelation to spiritual truths and comprehension of the right perspectives to any situation

B. Attributes:

1. As with Joseph it will elevate and promote you in the hardest of times
2. As with Daniel it benefited God's people tremendously as well as promote him

### 3.4. Step 5c IV The Spirit of Counsel

- A. Definition: The ability to offer the perfect advise and to communicate - information in helping change another's decision and perspective Proverb 15: 22 and 20:5 often the person has their own answer!
- B. Attributes:
  - 1. As a legal adviser who advises us of our legal rights and positions
  - 2. It is also called guidance when wisdom can't be used
  - 3. Look to this Spirit resident inside you for inspired utterance that will communicate wisdom and lift the troubled Isaiah 50: 4 – 9

### 3.5. Step 5c V. The Spirit of power

- A. Definition: Demonstrating the power to act and overcome with boldness
- B. Attributes:
  - 1. It dispels timidity 2 Timothy1: 7
  - 2. It gives the ability to do Philippians 4: 13
  - 3. It adds spiritual, wilful, and emotional strength Roman5: 6
  - 4. It gives authority and influence Luke10: 19
  - 5. It gives physical strength Rom8: 11

### 3.6. Step 5c VI The Spirit of the knowledge of the Lord

- A. A Definition: the Revealer of the awareness attributes and character of God to be acquainted with or to recognise God
- B. B Attributes:
  - 1. It is the knowledge of the glory of God and of His Son
  - 2. It is also experiencing Him this by knowing Him closely
  - 3. It is the source of the God-kind of the life John17: 3

### 3.7. Step 5c VII The Spirit of the fear of the Lord

- with as an inner result:

“The special joy - anointing from Hebrew1: 9”!

*Please do study now first: the last part of our former Step 2 incl. scripts about: “The fear of the Lord” Starting down on page 2 here you'll find that what I shared on those 3 God-fearing man: Starting with “Sadock “!*

Definition: The Revealer of the awesome God as the Judge of the sin and Hater and Destroyer of evil. He kept Sadock faithful: Habakkuk 3 - He changed his heart and to Malachi 4 - He gave confidence and joy!

Attributes:

It hates evil Proverb 8: 13 as: disaster, misfortune, injury, damage!

It brings fruitfulness Exodus.1: 17 and verse 21

It is a sin deterrent Exodus 20: 20

It brings blessings on us and our children Deuterium 5: 29

It causes prolonged days Proverb 9: 10 -11

It gives us preservations Proverb19:

It brings deliverance 2 Kings 17: 39

It merits earned respect Nehemiah 5: 9

It gives authority Nehemiah 7: 2

It ensures we are taught of the Lord Psalm 25: 12

It causes friendship with God and revelation of the covenant

## 4. Step 5 – d (1) The Holy Spirit of God

the fruits of this awesome Being

In [Galatians 5: 21 - 22](#) it speaks here about the 9 fruits of the Spirit - a result of the intimate relation between a human being and “The Holy Spirit of God” - these fruits are:

*Love - joy - peace - patience - kindness - goodness -  
faithfulness - meekness and self-control*

This by His unique gift of grace! Already in the gospels our Lord Jesus was teaching about this particular exchange at hand - later perhaps more on this subject in further [Step 5](#) lessons to come; In [Acts 2](#) we see Peter as first of all operating in the gifts and administrations as mentioned in [Joel 3](#) and in [1 Corinthians 12](#) - a breaking through birth of [Zoë](#) life; this to Gods honour and Glory!

Imagine now: a new born Christian has received a perfect and complete new spirit but still spiritual growth is desperately needed for the rest of his whole inner being as this will allow and enable him / her to walk by the light and in the power of that new nature! Therefore inner spirituality is to be measured by the fruit - development of the Holy Spirit in a Christian’s live - which will be seen outwardly on a consistent base by a walking in wisdom and by an experienced sanctified way of live - this with a refined [heart](#) attitude - a big pleasure to God !

6. Confess / proclaim the Word and renew your mind by it! –

## 5. Step 5 – d (2): The holy Spirit of the Lord!

Commitment unto the promise: to never bring up an offence to one who hurts you. It's a delivering power. Some further keys to love your enemy are: prayer - blessing - overcome with good! Your love will / can soften the heart of the other - 1Peter 4: 8.

### 5.1. Love -1 Corinthians13

All fruits are based on love please read about it in:

Romans12: 9; Romans13: 8; Ephesians 3: 14 – 19 and 1John 4: 8!

### 5.2. 2 Joy - there are 2 kinds of joy:

- A. Temporal, like: results of success, delight, satisfied desires, etc.
- B. A conditioned of state of soul - a joyful person has a strong character in God as He has learned to release the Joy from his spirit into his soul.

Read now please next scriptures about the obtaining of this fruit:

Matthew13: 44; John15: 11; Romans14: 17 and 1Thessalonians 5:16

### Joy as a result of praise:

It gets your mind to God of yourself

It will start things to share: inner - out!

Unlocks doors in your life

Releases bonds around and in you

### The further result of joy

It brings: strength, power, character, healing, patience and serves as a protector.

### 5.3. 3. Peace

Quietness and rest and friendliness and a calm state of mind; about this please do read:

The ability that enables you to persevere and hang on to your faith even in the middle of crisis and /or hardships so forbearance, endurance, longsuffering and restraint are all part of it and together they stand in for a person who has the power to explode but who exercise restraint instead from out of the inner new man !

Proverbs 16: 32, Luke8: 15 / 21: 19, Colossians 3:12, Hebrews 12:11

### 5.5. 5. Gentle - / kindness

The moral excellence in character: to be good / kind **and** not to overwhelm others. In Greek: reasonable - forbearing - fair: close to weakness: 1Timothy 3: 3 and 6: 11 More to be read in:

John 3: 16 -18, 2 Timothy 2: 24, 1 Tessaioniens2: 7 - 8.



### 5.6. 6. Goodness

Being good in doing God's goodness - about this aspect read please:

**Psalm 62: 19; Ephesians 2: 10; Titus 2: 14 and 1 Peter 2: 12!**

### 5.7. 7. Self-control

So this is having power over your self, restraint over one's impulses, emotions and desires - all by a deeper relation with this precious Spirit

**1Corinthians 9: 24 - 27; 2 Timothy 2: 4 - 5 / 3:1-3, 1 Peter 2: 11**

### 5.8. 8. Kindness

This is goodness in action; also helpful. In the Greek: Philanthropic - love for mankind; readiness to help. About God's sample in kindness, please do read these:

**Isaiah 54: 10; Luke 6: 35; Romans 2: 4 / 3: 12; Ephesians 2: 4 -10 and Colossians 3:12**

### 5.9. 9. Faithfulness

Being loyal to others - read about this in a.o.:

***Nehemiah 13: 13; Psalm 81: 23; Matthew 25: 21; 1Corinthians 4:1-2; Hebrews 3: 2 / 12:1-7; Revelation 2: 10***

*The reward here:" The Crown of life"!*

#### How to walk and to develop in these:

1. Renewing your mind by the Word
2. Set your mind on above things
3. Yield over - become desperado to Him
4. Abide in the Lord. This by: **taking care / beware against robbers** - about which in a later lesson more; this in view on prevention against these evil influences!

#### Robbers to beware of are:

*Worry, fear / confusion, unforgiving, bitterness, jealousy, strife, selfishness, laziness, gossiping, wrath, heartiness, immorality and a lack of knowledge and wisdom about the flesh and the attacks of the enemy;*

#### Some scriptures to encourage you in this process are:

2 Corinthians 5: 17 till all of ch.6 this about the priests grace-administration

Matthew 11: 28 - 29 here: Jesus teaching about His kind of character and heart

1 Timothy 6: 11 here about a yearning pursue to spiritual fruits - spite of to money

2 Peter 1: 4 - 8 as following up process of the development in 1 Peter 4& 5

1 Corinthians 6: 17 do pursue it with all of your heart!

This concludes the: Step 5 b - take quality time to study on this lesson and do pay special attention to the scriptures added - our next lesson on this valuable subject will be Step 5 c which will explain bit more about: "The Gifts of the Holy Spirit"!

## 6. Holy Spirit - 5e The mercy gifts of the Spirit!

Roman 12 - about the: "Do - gifts"!

According to Roman12 & 1Corinthians12 we discern 2 kinds of gifts. Now we'll take first a look to the Roman12 do gifts! Looking to this chapter we notice a beautiful principle of: protective security! The gifts part we see in between of verses 3 - 8; verse 3 shows us His humility and after verse 8 it does share us about the inner transformation process!

Remember the story in Ezekiel 27 & 28 about Lucifer's fall - now for him our walking in the anointed gifts is like a poison; a reminder to his former state of life but: Praise be to God who provided to us a precious Sacrifice long before creation:

**"The holy and spotless Lamb of the Lord"!**

The Lord Jesus did pave that way for us - see: Luke1: 74 -75 to enable us to approach in great freedom but with fear the throne of his Father: a strong blessing - guaranteed by His sacrifice - a strong foundation during the development of that fruit and those gifts needed during our serving in the administrations of the Holy Spirit → Step5 d!

One of the gifts here is the gift of: Prophecy as prophecy in the serving ministry this can be of great use by serving our Lord; these gifts and the fruits will develop well by walking in His presence; so an advice: hold on during the process! Besides Prophecy we also find here the gift of: Teaching the Word - another ability to serve a.o. the just converted / the young and also the more advanced Christians!

Just mention the warning to all of us: serve in simplicity under His guidance with **zeal** and out of a joyful heart! These gifts and fruits 'll develop excellently during our intimate relation with our Lord → the result will be a real blessing as mentioned in Romans 12: 1 - 2 as a very precious fragrance unto Him – br Paulo !

## 7. Holy Spirit 5 e 2

Now up to the gifts in: 1Cor12 & 14.

The above mentioned protective - attitude is needed in order to help us during the growth of the spiritual fruits and the chances in character aspects - this to keep us far from the danger of pride as mentioned in Roman12: 3; for now please read:

Joel 3 up verse 28 - 1Corinthians12 & 14& Philippians / Colossians 1: 9-11

So far about this first part on Stap 5 c1 (a) - be blessed and till next part - !

Provision and preparation

As we sow - did our heavenly High Priest take His cleansing blood to the Fathers throne to be spread on the mercy seat in heaven; then after that He authorized the Holy Spirit to share the Ephesians 4: 12 administrations to the church on earth and our Lord did send the Holy Spirit to bless us with His gifts. This church functions by serving in these administrations and gifts a blessing to the Father! Then there are also: deacons equipping the believers by encouraging them and by showing them the Lords compassion and care!

God is: "Aghape love"!

All of these gifts are functioning by the Lord's divine love; this love is essential to function as His administrators! So realize: it concerns His holy priesthood and it will depend to the heart

of the administrator which measure of gifts will be given; so be well prepared and available for the moment *if* He calls and needs you to come and work in His garden!

*Here a brief resume on these gifts*

1. Gifts of power

Faith - subdivided in special branches of faith: working of Powers; healing -gifts and gifts of supernatural Strength needed in a particular ministries and administrations!

2. Vocal gifts

Tongs - Translation of tongs and Prophecy a big blessing to be used for strengthening and encourage others and to reveal perspective views unto fellow believers!

3. Revelation - gifts

The Words of wisdom and the Word of knowledge and the gift of Discernment: a good clear view in the working world of spirits - dreams and visions telling us about things to that'll come to pass sooner or later

*About these sets of gifts **bit** more will be shared in Step 6 - the Word of the Lord and in Step 7 about expression before the face of the Lord in this Step much more on the Vocal gifts shown in Joel 3 and 1 Corinthians 12 & 14 specially on the practising part !*

## 8. Step 5f The Holy Spirit -The administrations of the Holy Spirit

INTRO to Step5f

After sharing in Step 5 a on the Isaiah 11: 1-3 Spirit of God and in Step 5 b-e about His fruits & gifts now to Step 5 f: about the administrations of this precious Spirit. He who manifests God's glory unto us as the fire full and Holy Breath of God and of whom our Lord Jesus declared that it would be better if He should leave them by going back to His Father as this would enable Him to descend that precious Holy Spirit in His place!

This point of view must have shocked them a lot but our Lord comforted them with the promise that He was going to send a Comforter whom would inhabit in them and stay at their site for always! Acts 1-2 shows us the outcome of this valuable promise!

In this Step 5d we'll conduct about some of His administrations! Realize this precious Spirit will be our Helper to reach the purpose of Jesus with us - see: 1 Peter 2: 8-10; a beautiful perspective about ministering along with this precious Spirit

### 8.1. A OVERVIEW on this MINISTRY

1. It would be better, more profitable, advantageous and beneficial for Jesus and them to go to the Father ...! This statement must have shocked the disciples immensely after being 3 years phys with the Bread of Life,
2. The Resurrection, the Way & the Truth and the Good Shepherd!
3. The Holy Spirit would be Jesus: Representative Matthew 28: 20.
4. Bringing conviction and reproof to the world

5. Bringing assurance and comfort for us to replace the sorrow of not being physically with Jesus; Another Minister of the same kind as Jesus was to them! So for them and you the reality of the 3 rd. Person of the Trinity who should be more real than as your Spouse or best Friend - for do realise: He is "God's Love".
6. We are not left desolated as orphans with no one to understand or help!

#### 8.2. B COMFORTER

1. Consoler, Crutch, Encourager, Someone to lean / depend on Acts 9: 31.
2. Especially in times of grief for lost ones or during pressure / loneliness!
3. Like a blanket or quilt on a freezing night: wrap yourself in the blanket of peace; cocoon of joy; a bubble of relief and rest in His warming arms - also see 2 Corinthians 13: 3

#### 8.3. C COUNSELOR

1. By revealing things about Jesus and future things - John 16: 13-14.
2. Who will assist by all quests He will teach us in all things!
3. Who will guide you into reality and wisdom from above: Roman 8: 14!
4. He will remind us of: Jesus Words. This is a of great essence because of ignorance and dullness of perception we have by being in a human - body: Roman 8: 26

#### 8.4. D HELPER

Energizer who'll inspire us to take times with the Lord Jesus and show direction in working for / with Him: 2 Corinthians 3: 5-6!

#### 8.5. E INTERCESSOR / ADVOCATE

1. The Helper and Mediator for identification Roman 8: 26-27.
2. He knows and lives in your heart to take your cares - relieve your stress and experience all you go through and make you victorious in them!
3. He prays out divine surprises where the prayer of faith won't work yet.
4. He is your legal Assistant, Lawyer and Friend!
5. He helps you plead the many aspects of your individual cases!
6. He has sealed you with the stamp of ownership Ephesians 1: 27 - 29.

#### 8.6. F STRENGTHENER of OUR FAITH

1. He'll get you ready for rough places as you can feel His work in you in advance to prepare you for what lies ahead!
2. He fortifies you like a hot meal on a bitterly cold day
3. He does this on a daily basis by prayer and the Word
4. He strengthens and energizes us to bear witness and testify of Jesus which brings glory unto God John 15: 26-27!
5. Look to the new man inside of you; this before undertaking a demanding task. Smith Wiggles worth said that:  
"I am a hundred times bigger on the inside of me than I am on the outside."

The inside: *the newborn man – let him reigns over the old man's flesh!*

### 8.7. G HE WHO STANDS US BY during THE PROCESS

1. He is like a map or compass or torch to give direction in times of darkness. He knows where the light switch is in the tunnel or cave
2. He is like 3 rd gear in the car to give the power to climb the steep places
3. He makes you a more then over comer 1 John 4: 4 He is like an extra supply - pack with *in-exhaustible* resources: Philippians 1: 9 -11

### 8.8. HE WHO PREPARES THE BRIDE OF:"THE LAMB"!

This precious Spirit is also the Architect and Builder of that City in Hebrew 12: 22-24 with its Temple of: living stones - see: 1 Peter 2: 2-10! Realize He's completing a mission unto our Redeemer: Lord Jesus the Christ! In Genesis we see a sample of this in Abraham's faithful servant who was descended to go and find by guidance of the Holy Spirit - a bride for Isaac: Abraham's son and he completed that mission - so will He!

Mention it's the Lord's desire that we'll lurn to move - this under His guidance; in these administrations of the Holy Spirit like Jesus did show to us in: Isaiah 61 & Luke 4! So let's → **well** prepared and equipped - now - start to walk in those works which He prepared for us and wave our linen garment as mentioned in Revelation 19! To enjoy His support in these we'll need to walk in close relation with this precious Spirit of the Lord!

This concludes the lesson Step 5 d! Looking forward to share unto you about the supportive manifestations of the Holy Spirit in our next and last lesson on this topic:

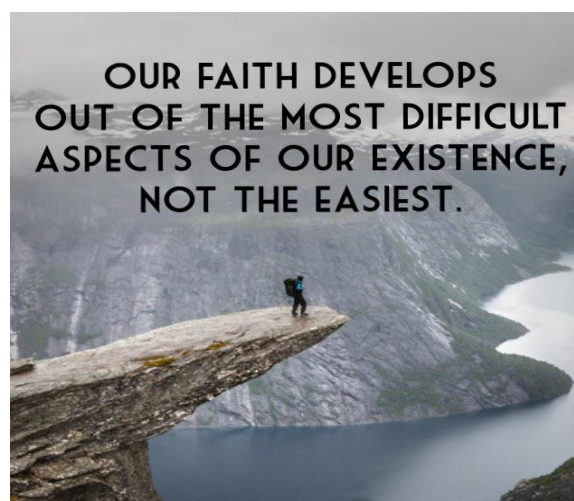

## 9. Step 5 g- (a) About the character of the Holy Spirit

**2 Peter1: 5 - 9**



Divine development of His characters in us His nearest!

About this subject we can read in the following scripture Marc 16: 14 where our Lord shows His grieves about the heart conditions of His youngsters who ought to be joyful and powerful

followers of Him as they saw Him working and preaching for 3 years - it appeared however that their hearts still needed a big and deeper exchange - a solution to this problem is shown by the invitation of Jesus in Matthew 11: 28 - 29. Here He does offer a gateway to their heart exchange → that'd cost Him an awful lot!

I need to refer here a moment to [Hebrew 5: 7](#) and to that struggle of Jesus shown in the John 19 garden of Gethsemane; here our Lord took that marriage cup for His bride this to become that Sacrifice as prophetic announced by David in Psalm 40: 8 - a total surrender to the will of His Father as:

**“The Lamb to be slaughtered”!**

The greatest part in these inner exchanges would however take place during those 40 -days teachings from Jesus right after His resurrection there in that upper room just before the Lord taken Him to heaven. There He did teach them deeply **all** about the [“Kingdom of His Father”!](#) In order to prepare and enable them to receive that great [Promise](#) and to start operating in that new mission of the [Holy Spirit](#) as shown in p.e.:

*[Isaiah 11: 1 - 3](#) & [Joel 2: 28](#); [John 15: 26](#)*

Remember what I shared in [Step 4](#) on the Ephesians church and the backsliding from their 1st. love in Revelation 2: 1-7 this caused by the dangers in Ephesians 4: 28 - 31. Here we saw that someone can easily grieve the Spirit of God by whom he /she is sealed just by site tracking and by no longer yielding unto Him - so be aware and do stay close to Him by: exercising in listening to His very gentle voice what'll become a Balm in our souls: here our Lord serves us with some particular Script parts with abilities to prevent us against those periods of desolation and backsliding!

This concludes Step 5 - 2 ( a) be blessed – your br. In Him!

Do remember here what I shared on Peter in [Step 3 b](#); after the Lord reconciled him there at that lake's shore and his empowering by the [Holy Spirit](#) in Acts 2 - he did become **the** by the Great Shepherd ordained: Shepherd unto His flocks in despair!

In both of his letters he shares deeply about the badly needed development of a divine character; which will be achieved by deep intimacy with their Lord even during severe hardships and persecutions as shown in 1 Peter 4 & 5:

*[Longsuffering an aspect developed during the sufferings for His Name sake;](#)  
[Exercises in humility and submission to the Great Shepherd and](#)  
[to each other and in endurance & dedication in the wrestling's and sustaining during the](#)  
[attacks of the evil one \(please do study on these 2 chapters severely\)!](#)*

Then in 2 Peter 1:1-9 he proceeds in teaching; starting with the virtue: Faith - cultivated by the above mentioned processes: I do **urge** you to study seriously on these parts in: 1 Peter 4 & 5 along with the subjects in our former 2 lessons: fruits & gifts as these will equip you well to serve the Lord in the [Administrations](#) of the [Holy Spirit](#) this unto more glory to the Most High and to the fulfilment of His purpose in and through us!

I'll conclude this [Step 5 c2](#) now with a brighter view on: *Rebirth* - a subject I did share on in earlier lessons! This process takes place in the [New Jerusalem](#); in the [Heavenly Tabernacle](#) and well as in the [Arc](#) of the [Covenant](#); read about this in [Galatians 4: 26](#) where the New Jerusalem is called *the mother* so there she is mentioned as:

**[“The mother of all His reborn”!](#)**

In [Step 7](#) I'll share some more on:

The Rebirth and on the: New Covenant which is connected to this item!

for now I'll just slightly  
touch this interesting and most beautiful process!

The **Holy of Holiness** in the heavenly **Tabernacle** is a very sanctified and protected place so the: "**The Arc of Covenant**" with "the" sprinkled holy blood on its mercy seat is the perfect breathing place for His new to be born children! This does function as a womb in a mother's belly! These rebirths will take place by impartation of powerful **Seeds** of the **Word of God** and by breathing on it by the **Spirit of God** - A divine process of creation of everlasting incorruptible life; read now about this:

*Ezekiel 36: 26; 2 Timothy 1: 5 -7; Hebrew 10: 19 - 22; & John 3:5 -7.*

In the next **Step 5 d** lesson I'll show some about the divine and precious subject of:  
**"The administrations of the Holy Spirit"**

## 10. Step 5 h His manifestations

*"The Holy Spirit of the living God"*  
**Symbols / manif.**

### 10.1. Water;

*Isaiah 44: 3; Hosea 6: 3 & 10: 12 - John 4: 14 & 7: 38 – 39.*

**Explanation:** This speaks of washing / cleansing and that which satisfies spiritual thirst and it brings cool refreshing; also a symbol of the precious Word of the Lord

### 10.2. Fire

*Exodus 19: 18 - Isaiah 1: 25; Malachi 3:2-3; Matthew 3: 11;  
Acts 2: 3; Hebrew 12: 29*

**Explanation:** This speaks of the purifying heat and fiery zeal or compassion!

### 10.3. Wind or Breath

*Isaiah 40: 7; John 3: 8; Acts 2: 2.*

**Explanation:** This speaks of His invisible presence of a noticeable occurrence in Gods breath and movements

### 10.4. Oil

*Mark 6: 13; Luke 4: 18; Acts 10: 38; James 5: 14;  
1 John 2: 20 - 27!*

**Explanation:** This speaks of the supernatural enablement given to His priests for consecration to service and the balm of healing used for medicinal purposes and joy - Isaiah 61: 3 – 5 – Paulo !

#### 10.5. The Dove

*Genesis 1: 2; Matthew 3: 16 & 10: 16.*

**Explanation:** This speaks of purity - beauty, gentleness, peace and the sensitivity of the Holy Spirit - because of these quality doves were sent out after the flood and did return with the proof of new existing life!

#### 10.6. The Seal

*Ephesians 1: 13 & 4: 30; 2 Timothy 2: 19'*

**Explanation:** This speaks of ownership - authenticity and security of the Most High. In Roman times the official seal was stamped with a signet ring an authority and then the box or letter was sealed so that it was insured for safe transport!

#### 10.7. Dew

*Psalm 133:1-3; Hosea 14: 6.*

**Explanation:** This speaks of the refreshing as Dew only comes in the stillness of the night upon morning grass; nowadays He still infuses His most intimate servants during their very close intercourses with Him!

#### 10.8. The promised Gift

*John 14: 17; Acts 2: 38 - 39!*

**Explanation:** This speaks of the tremendous Blessing for the Church age which only the Jewish priests, prophets, kings under the old covenant experienced in an anointing that only came "upon" them to function in their offices and occasionally on workmen and musicians in the Tabernacles of Moses & David and in the Temple of Solomon!

#### 10.9. The Finger of God

*Matthew 12: 28; Luke 11: 20.*

**Explanation:** This speaks about the little power necessary to dispel demons or to touch His beloved once!

#### 10.10. The Hand of God

*1 Kings 18: 46; Acts 11: 21!*

**Explanation:** A move of God which donates the strength of / by His powerful hand.

#### 10.11. The Arm of the Lord

*Isaiah 53: 1; Ephesians 1: 19 -20.*

**Explanation:** All of God's power was necessary to raise Jesus body from the dead because Jesus body had to become sin on our behalf and was turned over to all the powers of darkness and death for a period of 3 days!

#### 10.12. The Earnest, Pledge or Down-Payment

*2 Corinthians 1: 22 & 5: 5 and Ephesians 1: 13-14!*

**Explanation:** This speaks of a small fraction of blessings and inheritance that we have in this short lifespan compared with the eternal big once to come!



### 10.13. First fruits

Roman 8: 23.

**Explanation:** This speaks about our relative small harvest now in comparison with that one that will come and be shown after the complete redemption of the body: Similar to pledge.

### 10.14. New Wine

*Matthew 9: 17; Ephesians 5: 18-20!*

**Explanation:** This speaks of the: bursting out / joyful quality of the Holy Spirit's energy and His ability to be sustained to natural pressures and surroundings and to make us strong and bold in our actions: Wine is usually used in reference to the blood of our beloved: Lord Jesus Christ.

### 10.15. The Cloud of Glory

*2 Chronicles 5: 14; 2 Corinthians 10: 1-2.*

**Explanation:** This speaks of His unpredictable Presence which is barely visible yet it does obscure much activity beyond

### 10.16. Electricity

*Mark 5: 25-34; Luke 6: 19; Acts 19: 11 -12.*

**Explanation:** The Holy Spirit's power in the healing anointing like electricity is conductible / transferable and capable of being stored. It flows through certain conductors and will only go into certain things like clothes and: it is tangible!

### 10.17. Laser Beam

*Habakkuk 3: 4; 1 John 1: 5*

**Explanation:** Just as a laser can cut through 4 inches of steel and requires many mirrors to work so the Holy Spirit power - channelled through intercession can: **touch / deliver** people, cities and nations when but simply binding the devil over them is not the key for the answer of their response to God - as in 2 Corinthians 3: 18 we see that the purpose of God to man is to absorb and reflect His glory!

### 10.18. Dynamite Greek root word for: "power" - used in → Acts 1: 8

Read about this more in:

*Luke 24: 49 - Acts 4: 33 & 6: 8; 1 Corinthians 2: 4; 2 Timothy 1: 6 -7*

**Explanation:** The just "being - full" of this Dynamite is not enough here as there are many Spirit (power) filled Christians around but as we see with Stephen - he was also: **full of faith / love** which activated that power. The result was that Stephen did great miracles among the people: faith comes from the hearing of the Word of God and lights the fuse that is attached to the Dynamite - power of the Holy Spirit of God!
